Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

The Texas Education is mandated by Texas State Law under the Texas Education Code, Section 25.006 to collect data on military-connected students enrolled in Texas public schools. Because of this law, Judson ISD is required to collect this information on every student enrolled in our district. In addition, Judson I.S.D. receives Federal Impact Aid from the Federal Government under the Title VII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act Public Law 103-382. Federally connected students are those whose home address is on a U.S. military base or other eligible federal property or whose parent/guardian is either serving on active duty with the U.S. uniformed services or is employed in some capacity on federal property.

Because of the Impact Aid law, Judson ISD is eligible to receive funds from the federal government to operate and maintain our schools and enrich school programs. In order to receive the Impact Aid financial assistance, the U.S. Department of Education requires our school district to survey each student to determine eligibility. Students with parents in the Uniformed Services (active military, foreign military, or reservist on Presidential orders) are eligible. However, civilians are also eligible if they are employed on federal property such as JBSA military installations such as Lackland, Randolph and Ft. Sam Houston. This includes all offices, stores, restaurants/food courts, construction sites, etc. Employment can be government or contracted, as long as the parent works on the federal property on the survey date. There are examples of other eligible properties listed on the survey form. Please be informed, the address of the employer and the physical work address is required. Also, a separate form must be completed for each of your children enrolled in the Judson ISD. If you have a child who did not receive a survey form, please contact the child's campus administrator.

Be assured that all information collected on the form is confidential and used only for the stated purpose. The Impact Aid Survey application provides only collective information on the numbers and locations of federally connected students attending our schools. Please complete both forms by printing legible. On the Impact Aid Survey form, complete the student information in parts A, B and C. The survey form must be signed and dated by the parent or legal guardian in Part D.

Your cooperation in completing the form, signed and dated will be greatly appreciated. Please return the form to your child's school by November 10, 2022. The more forms returned, the greater the amount of funds available to
